

## VISITATION AT KINGS HARBOR MULTICARE CENTER

As per New York State Department of Health Guidelines and Regulations for Nursing Home Visitation during a Public Health Emergency there are now two options for visiting residents at Kings Harbor.

Please see the Fact Sheets describing the options for visiting.

If you have been appointed as the designated caregiving visitor and will be visiting on unit, we ask that you cancel any previously made appointments for off unit visits so there will be additional space for family members who are not the designated caregivers.

### **OPTION 1**

#### **Off Unit Scheduled Visits:**

1. Appointment is required. Call 718-405-3506 to schedule an appointment.
2. Visits are held on the patio or main floor dining rooms.
3. A Covid-19 Negative test result is **not** required.
4. Two persons at a time may visit but resident may have multiple family members schedule visits.

### **OPTION 2**

#### **Designated Personal/Compassionate Caregiving Visits:**

1. Residents may designate **two individuals** as caregiver visitors.
2. All designated caregiver visitors must register and obtain a facility ID prior to the first visit.
3. All designated caregiver visitors must present a negative Covid-19 test result from within the past seven days to visit on unit.
4. Visits will be held in the resident's room between the hours of 11:00 am and 7:00 pm.
5. Designated caregivers may only visit one at a time.
6. Once registered, no appointment is necessary to visit.
